## Terms & Conditions

- Booking is by donation only, suggested £2 per child.
- All activities are suitable for ages 5 and over.
- Children and adults should wear comfortable outdoor clothing that may get dirty.
- Children will need to bring a 500ml water bottle or similar for the bird feeder activity. All other equipment provided.
- Bird cake activity is not suitable for children who are allergic to seeds or nuts or who cannot touch bread.
- Visits must only be cancelled in extenuating circumstances and Thames21 must be notified at least 1 week in advance.
- Thames21 reserves the right to cancel a visit if weather conditions are deemed unsafe or if adult to child ratio is not met.

The group leader is responsible during the visit for making sure that:

- Adults must supervise children at all times and are responsible for their behaviour.
- Minimum ratio of 1 adult to 5 children and maximum group size of 25 children is maintained throughout the visit.
- Group leaders will need to provide any specific medication for children or have the child's parent attend the visit.
- All visitors bring their own lunch with them on the day.

### Driving to the centre:

Birchen Grove is a minor road off Blackbird Hill Road with traffic lights at the junction. Follow the signs to the garden centre. We share their drive. Drivers should stop in the car park, not on the road. Please take extreme care when driving in the centre car park.
