Remove litter

This is far from an average litter pick. Any foreshore litter removal experience is a real eye-opener, revealing not only the weird and wonderful things that end up in the river, but also the extent to which our rivers are choking on plastic. Ideal for: boosting morale and inspiring your team to care about their impact on the environment.

Control invasive species

Himalayan Balsam is doing untold damage to our river banks. This non-native, invasive plant may look pretty in pink, but it grows quickly and colonises the river, suffocating our native river species. This activity is best performed during the Spring. Ideal for: broadening minds and staff enrichment.

Restore the river

Enhance the river for fish, invertebrates and plants using restoration techniques such as weir removal and gravel riffle introduction. Seeing the river evolve and improve throughout the day as a result of your team's efforts is one of the most rewarding experiences we know. Ideal for: strengthening team bonds and enhancing communication.

Manage vegetation and woodland

A river needs light in order to thrive, but overgrown tree canopies limit plant diversity and prevent aquatic plants from naturally restoring many of our rivers. Using bow saws, grass hooks and loppers, your team will clear vegetation and use it to build 'dead hedges' and habitats for invertebrates, reptiles and amphibians.

Plant a reed bed

Reed beds are vital habitats for healthy rivers, but many have been lost due to urbanisation. Installing a reed bed is a challenging yet fun building experience, which leaves behind a green legacy for wildlife. Thames21 has already reintroduced kilometres of reed bed along the Lee Navigation. Ideal for: improving communication and team bonding.

Clean up with canoes

As an extension to the litter pick, we can arrange for smaller groups to pick litter using canoes, bringing a whole new dimension to the experience. Ideal for: inspiring creativity in the workplace and strategic team work.



The experiences* are held on a number of London's rivers including...

The Thames, Brent, Ravensbourne, Quaggy, Lea, Cray and Jubilee.
