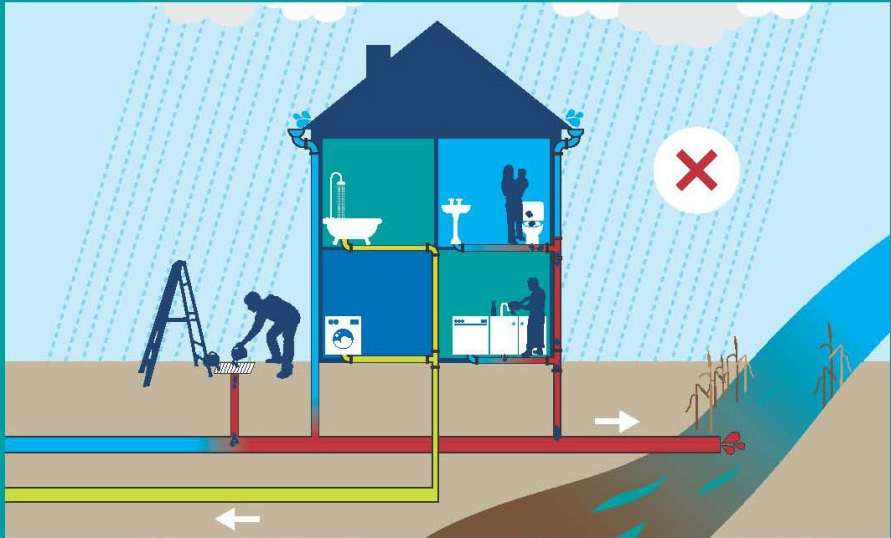


ONLY RAIN IN RIVERS

PLEASE HELP CLEAN UP YOUR LOCAL OPEN SPACES AND WATERWAYS BY MAKING YOUR PLEDGE:



Plumbing in a new appliance? Connect right first time – ask for a Thames Water WaterSafe accredited plumber, or know how to connect your pipes properly if you're doing DIY. Visit www.connectright.org.uk to find out more.



Get your misconnections corrected. Check your home for existing misconnections and get them fixed – go to www.connectright.org.uk for further information.



Don't cause blockages in pipes and sewers. Do not use your loo as a litter bin, or pour fats and oils down the kitchen sink – search “Bin It Don't Block It” for help and advice from Thames Water.



Only rain down the drain. Don't pour paint or throw food waste down surface water drains which lead straight to the river.
