



Terms & Conditions for London Rivers Week 2026 Photography Competition

1. Photographs should be taken in one of the 32 boroughs covered by the Greater London Authority.
2. You do not have to be a resident of London to enter.
3. You need to be aged 16 or over to take part in the competition.
4. Photographs must be entered within a category: Community and conservation, wild by the water, and the River Thames through the seasons.
5. We can only accept digital images.
6. Images should be in jpeg. format and have a minimum file size of 1Mb, and maximum 10Mb. Please do not send any emails with total attachments over 10Mb.
7. London National Park City or Thames21 will not accept responsibility for lost or damaged entries.
8. Photographers will retain copyright for their work, however, Thames21 & London National Park City will maintain the right to exhibit and use images in print and online for purposes of promoting its charitable works.
9. **Photographers will always be accredited.**
10. Entrants must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries (or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured) - on the understanding that the image can be used in accordance with point number 8 in these Terms and Conditions of entry.
11. One entry per permission is permitted to the three categories.
12. We take appropriate physical, electronic, and managerial measures to ensure we keep your information secure. We will not share your data with any third-party organisation.
13. All personal information provided in relation to the competition will be treated in accordance with our privacy policy details of which can be found on our website. at <https://www.thames21.org.uk/privacy-policy/>

14. The closing date of the competition is **1st May 2026**. Entries must reach us by 5pm on 8th May 2026.
15. Judging will be based on a single image and not a series of images.
16. The winning entries will be announced on Tuesday 26th May 2026.
17. The winning entry will receive: a Fujifilm X-half camera, a Fujifilm x Link WIDE printer with film, a paperback edition of *Is A River Alive?* by Robert Macfarlane and £50 gift voucher
18. There will be two runners-up who will each receive a voucher of £25 each, a Fujifilm x Link WIDE printer with film and a paperback edition of *Is A River Alive?* by Robert Macfarlane.
19. Submission of a photograph for the competition is taken as an agreement to abide by the above rules.
